Gateway Review Workshops — Gateway reviews are independent peer reviews of major procurement projects at defined decision points in programs and projects. The training workshops have been designed and tailored for public and private sector personnel wanting to learn more about the Gateway process and what's involved with participating in Gateway Reviews. The following programs are available.

Familiarisation Workshop

Who should attend

Suitable for prospective reviewers, project teams and agency staff who are interested in learning more about Gateway.

What the program offers

The workshop covers:

- the purpose and principles of Gateway
- NSW Treasury's requirements for Gateway reviews
- the process for conducting a review
- useful tools developed to support the process.

At the end of this session, participants will understand how the Gateway process works and the roles of review participants.

Participants will know and understand:

- the principles upon which Gateway is based
- projects/equipment procurements for which Gateway reviews are mandated
- how to plan and participate in a Gateway Review
- roles and responsibilities of Gateway Review participants
- the seven key success factors of Gateway
- the relationship between Gateway and the broader procurement process.
