WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This course is for:

- those with responsibility for corruption risk management or corruption prevention
- managers across the whole of the public sector
- internal auditors, internal ombudsmen, risk managers, corporate governance and human resources professionals.

WHAT THE PROGRAM OFFERS

No public sector agency is immune from corruption risks. Risk management is a well known concept that can be used as a framework for dealing with corruption risks. By using this approach, agencies can identify and prevent corruption risks in a proactive way.

This practical course focuses on corruption risk management and looks at how risk management principles in general can be applied to corruption prevention in particular.

Using a risk management framework, participants are guided through a process of identifying specific corruption risks and their potential treatment strategies. There is an opportunity throughout the course to apply this knowledge to a case study of a fictional agency.

The program also demystifies the ICAC by examining the role, function and processes of NSW's public sector corruption watchdog.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Participants will:

- define and identify corrupt conduct, and understand the role of the ICAC in minimising and investigating corruption in NSW
- understand how a risk management approach can be applied in preventing corruption
- identify the areas and functions in an organisation that may be a higher corruption risk
- be aware of a range of strategies to manage corruption risks
- apply this knowledge to a practical case study.

This team is responsible for providing advice and support to public sector agencies that have experienced, or are vulnerable to corruption.
